Goals in defining and assessing responsible mining (I)



he European Unior

Increase awareness in Europe

- Increase the EC's awareness and know-how of sustainability criteria for raw materials
- Increase awareness for policy discussions that include sustainability issues
 in social and environmental topics and impacts
- Examine the use of sustainability concepts in both developing and industrialized countries (including EU countries)

Harmonisation:

- Harmonise national and EU activities on sustainable mining
- Link up with **parallel processes**, such as the debate on how to cope with conflict minerals
- Link up with the EU process on "Business and Human Rights" (e.g. national action plans)













Goals in defining and assessing responsible mining (II)



the European Union

Create a common understanding

 Create industry-wide acceptance of what the main sustainability challenges in mining and good environmental and socio-economic standards are

Explore practical approaches

- Recommend how to include environmental and human-rights impacts and risks
- Set up guidelines on responsible mining for EU DGs and other agencies
- Discuss tools or instruments to be implemented for further action by EU policy makers, investors or industries (what is needed?)
